## **Outcome of our consultation regarding return to 3pm finish time from October 2024 (Autumn Term 2)**

Further to my recent letter dated 8<sup>th</sup> October 2024, I am writing to confirm that the consultation has now closed.

Thank you for your responses; we received 20 in total.

The outcome is that from **Monday 28<sup>th</sup> October lunch time will reduce from 40minutes to 30minutes for all students and the school day will end at 3pm**. School buses will leave at 3:10pm.

Responses received raised the following:-

### **Can all students have lunch in 30 minutes?**

We have closely monitored the situation since the start of this academic year and are confident that all students can get through comfortably in 30minutes. The catering staff have worked hard to ensure they serve students quickly and efficiently and the changes made to the configuration in the dining hall has created more space.

### **Will extra curricular clubs still take place?**

While we recognise there is 10 minutes less time at lunch, we will continue to offer as many clubs as we can. After school clubs will not be impacted,
