The Governors' Policy on Academy Uniform must be followed by all students in years 7 to 11. Please ensure the correct uniform is worn at all times and correct equipment is brought into school.

UNIFORM FOR YEARS 7 TO 11 FOR 2025/26 ACADEMIC YEAR:

ADDITIONAL DRESS CODE REQUIREMENTS: JEWELLERY

Studded earrings only and a watch. A clear single small stud can be worn in nose piercings or a plaster worn over the piercing. No nose rings. No other piercings are allowed. Jewellery should be removed for practical subjects due to health and safety concerns. Earlobe stretchers and bars are NOT permitted. Religious jewellery can be worn but must be under clothing.

HAIR & MAKEUP

Make up must be discreet and kept to a minimum, hair colour should be in the range of natural hair colouring. No extreme hairstyles or colours. No false nails/nail extensions. Nails should be short for health and safety and to allow students to carry our daily tasks. Students who come to school with nail extensions will be expected to remove/cut/file them down. Eyelashes should be a natural length and thickness.

Students who are not correctly uniformed will be expected to borrow Academy uniform from our Uniform HUB (if available). Uniform infringements will be reported home via the Arbor app students will be issued with a one day uniform card. All uniform infringements should be rectified in a timely manner. Repeated failures to attend school in the correct uniform may lead to more severe consequences. Students that arrive to school not in the uniform may be sent home to rectify or parents asked to bring the uniform into school.

Students on day trips will be expected to wear uniform unless they are told otherwise.

At Countesthorpe Academy we want our students to be "the best they can be" and look and feel smart. We want them to be proud of the community to which they belong. It is expected that students will dress smartly and take pride in how they look. In coming to the Academy, parents and carers agree to support our policy in ensuring your child is correctly dressed. Uniform must be worn at all times, including the journey to and from school.

Failure to comply with our uniform policy or repeated uniform infringements may result in us placing students on a uniform improvement report, uniform improvement contract or directing the uniform that maybe worn for school. For example students who chose to wear a skirt maybe directed to wear trousers only if they fail to comply with our policy etc.

Aerosol deodorants/perfumes or air fresheners are not allowed. If deodorant is required a roll on or water based spray pump version is acceptable.

If for any reason your child does not have their PE kit or has a medical note explaining that they are unable to take part in the lesson, we are unable to make alternative provision. Our policy is similar to most secondary schools in that pupils who are not able to do PE are expected to change into their PE kit and join the PE group listening to the theory aspects and helping with duties as instructed by the teacher. This is also the same policy for outdoor lessons. It is therefore important that they have a coat and warm clothing to observe the lesson if they are outdoors.

If your child has forgotten their PE kit they will be expected to borrow spare kit from the PE department. This is washed regularly after each student use.

If your child has a medical condition that is likely to last for several weeks, please contact your child's PE teacher to explore arrangements that can be made in such exceptional circumstances. pestaff@clcc.college

The Headteacher's decision is final.

Parents are reminded that the Academy's Governing Body and Headteacher retain the right to insist that students attend Countesthorpe Academy appropriately and sensibly dressed. They reserve the right to exclude students from activities where dress is considered unsuitable for health and safety reasons.

Unsuitable dress includes:

- Shorts, leggings, trousers which are not in line with the Uniform Policy, or short skirts and crop tops
- Unprotected footwear such as sliders, Crocs, open toed shoes.
- Earrings and other jewellery which could be caught and pulled when moving around the academy and during practical lessons such as PE, Science, Design and Technology, Construction, Hair and Beauty etc
- Platform shoes or high heel shoes which are dangerous on floors and steps

ESSENTIAL EQUIPMENT LIST

Finally, I would like to detail our <u>Essential Equipment list</u>. All students attending Countesthorpe Academy should have the following essential items of equipment for their lessons, preferably stored in a simple, clear pencil case.

- Pen, pencil, ruler, rubber, sharpener
- Purple pen
- Highlighter
- Scientific Calculator
- Geometry Set
- 1:1 Device iPad (Y7-9) or Chromebook (Y10 & 11)
- Earphones/Headphones

We are <u>not</u> asking parents to send students into school with expensive Bluetooth/wireless ones (e.g. Apple AirPods). Our requirement is a simple, cheap and basic set of either earphones, or if uncomfortable, on-ear headphones that can connect to a computer, iPad etc using a 3.5mm audio jack.

Thank you in advance for your support in ensuring your child is in the correct uniform and equipment for school.

HOW TO ORDER A SCHOOL UNIFORM:

Uniform can be purchased from the school uniform provider - www.schoolwearsolutions.com

Items with logos must be purchased from the listed supplier. Anything else can be purchased from other stores as long as they are within the policy. The Headteacher's decision is final.

STUDENT ID CARDS

When a child starts at the Academy they will be issued with an ID Card and lanyard, which should be worn at all times. Your child is provided with this at the beginning of their time with us and should be kept safe as they will not be issued with a new one. Replacement Cards and/or Lanyards can be purchase online through www.parentpay.com

The ID card will allow students to:

- Pay for school lunches
- Book out library resources
- Use photocopiers
- Students can also purchase items of low monetary value such as pen, pencil, ruler etc.

Students must wear their ID card and lanyard at all times; it is part of their uniform.
